

Happy Resurrection
Sunday! On last Sunday,
we remembered that it
was "At the Cross" where
our Lord and Savior
showed His Love for all of
us! We spent Holy Week
celebrating at our Maundy
Thursday Worship and
with our youth...and some

adults...having a good time at our Annual Spring Festival. All of that culminates today, when we celebrate the "getting up" of our Lord and Savior! HE IS RISEN! I can remember Ms. Bell teaching us at the Mount Olive Baptist Church children's choir, "HE ROSE! HE ROSE!"NOW Ain't that GOOD NEWS?!


