## THE DEACON'S MESSAGE

The next day Jesus' mother was a quest at a wedding celebration in the village of Cana in Galilee. Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the celebration. The wine supply ran out during the festivities, so Jesus' mother spoke to him about the problem. "They have no more wine," she told him. Jesus told the servants, "Fill the jars with water." When the jars had been filled to the brim, he said, "Dip some out and take it to the master of ceremonies." So they followed his instructions. John 2:1-3, 7-8, NLT In the book of John, we learn about the first of many miracles Jesus would perform. It took place in the village of Cana in Galilee. Jesus does something that seems simple in comparison to the miracles that would follow. He turns water into wine. Since Jesus was invited to the celebration, the possibility of a miracle happening was infinitely increased. What would have happened if Jesus was not invited to the wedding? Have you invited Jesus into your life and the situations that concern you? Turning water into wine may not be the most heralded miracle of Christ, but it was still a miracle someone needed. 
