#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Our 135<sup>th</sup> Church Anniversary Celebration was a true blessing and all praise belongs to God! We certainly had "A Celebration of 135 Years of Being a People of Prayer and Praise". Thank you to those of you who attended and celebrated with us. We also thank those who served and helped plan the occasion. As a matter of fact, special thanks to everyone who gave of their time, talent and treasure during the month of October. Both our Whole Family Conference and our Harvest Festival were successful! We look forward to the rest of the year and to the Ministry activity that will take place.

As we "fall back" into standard time on the clock, let's "fall back" into being excited about being involved in the ministries of this congregation. Why? ## THE DEACON'S MESSAGE

Five thousand two hundred eighty feet is the equivalent of one mile. Walking a mile sounds easier than the aforementioned definition unless you have already traveled several miles and then are asked to go an additional mile. I will never forget training for a 10K race, which is about 6.2 miles. I am pleased to say I finished the race, but it would have been a lot easier if I had prepared for the full 6.2 miles instead of training for about 4.5 miles per day. What if you are asked to go the extra distance in life? What if someone is ill in your family and needs extra care on top of what you have already given? What happens when you feel you have already gone above the call of duty and exceeded the normal standards required by society? Do you quit? God expects more from His children. Matthew 5:41 (NKJV) says, "And whoever compels you to go one mile, go with him two." Are you ready to go the extra mile? Have you done the spiritual training necessary to complete the race?


