FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

I pray that every household received our phone message on Thursday, December 5, 2019. I pray that you received it as my being as transparent as I could be in 120 seconds. Now, you heard the facts... what will you do? Please, Brothers and Sisters, let's stretch forth our Faith in giving and participating at this Church in the final month of the year. "*For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.*" (John 3:16–17) I encourage each of us to not forget the ultimate Reason for the Season. I know it's cliché but it's very important that we remember what we shouldn't forget....it's all about Christ! THE DEACON'S MESSAGE

"Therefore everyone who hears these words of Mine, and acts on them, may be compared to a wise man who built his house on the rock. And the rain fell and the floods came, and the winds blew and slammed against that house; and yet it did not fall, for it had been founded on the rock. (Matthew 7:24,25, NASB) Sometimes we forget the work that we have put in prior to encountering a spiritual storm. If you have done what you are supposed to do by laying a good foundation, the storm will not overtake you. Every day you have the opportunity to build your faith in Christ Jesus. Faith in God is a choice. Being obedient to God is a choice. Trusting God is a choice. When you are doing what God asks you to do, you are strengthening your spiritual foundation. People are more apt to think about what they should have done when a storm occurs, rather than preparing for the storm in advance. You must not forget who controls the storm.
