FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



I want to begin this message by saying To God BE the Glory! First Calvary, this Sunday we celebrate being in in this Worship facility now for 10 Years. I didn't want this day to pass by without us giving God

thanks for all that's been done for us! Listen, Brothers and Sisters, there are congregations that are being closed or reposted, so we stand this morning in this place to say once again, GOD DID IT! Also, today is Leadership Sunday. We celebrate with our annual installation of leaders. As we sanction these who come forth as leaders, please don't let their moment of "celebrity" mock the servant's heart they should exhibit. As we take our Covenant stance to serve God and this congregation with all our heart, soul, mind and strength, I pray that each of us will do so whole heartedly. I also pray that each leader...and each member... will consecrate themselves to be true servants of the Kingdom. I would like to share the following regarding Servant Leadership from Into Thy Word: "Servant Leadership is based on values and character, so it is about "how we do things." Who we are as Christians needs to transcend in how we are with one another. Leadership that is effective, even in the business world, is more about how we treat and empower our workers and staff. We are with Christ, we are with one another, and we *bear with one another in love*. THE DEACON'S MESSAGE

God wanted to use Moses. We find this to be true in Exodus 3:10-11, NLT "...Now go, for I am sending you to Pharaoh. You must lead my people Israel out of Egypt." But Moses protested to God, "Whom am I to lead the people of Israel out of Egypt?" Imagine if Moses decided He would not follow God. His hand would not have been the one holding the staff that made the Red Sea part. Moses would have missed the adventure of a lifetime because he was looking at what he saw in the mirror instead of looking at his maker. God has a vision for you. Seize it. It will change your life forever.
