DIFFERENT IS GOOD!



Do you ever look at people and think about how different God made each person? Sometimes these differences cause people to make fun of each other, or even act violently toward one another. This describes the Jews and Samaritans; two groups of people in the Bible who hated each other! They went to different churches, used different Bibles, and avoided speaking to each other at all costs. But when Jesus came on the scene, He set out to be different. Jesus, who was a Jew, reached out to the Samaritans. He told stories about good Samaritans. Jesus even talked to a Samaritan woman when stopping to get a drink of water. Needless to say, she was very surprised to find a Jew speaking such kind words to her.

The deal is, Jesus was the greatest missionary to ever live. He loved all people and He reached out to the woman despite the fact that she was different from Him. Missionaries usually spend their lives in unusual places, talking to people with different skin, in different languages, and wearing different clothes. Jesus always looked past the outer appearances and right into a person's heart. He was interested in who they were not just how they were different.
