What can desiring money cause a person to do? (Proverbs 23:4-5)

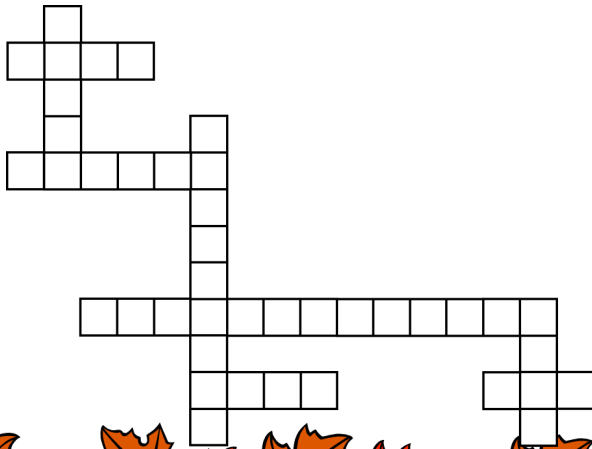
Where should you keep your treasure? (Matthew 6:19-21)

Chinese Dragon Game

Form a line. Hold hands with the person on each side of you. The first person in line is the leader and walks around in a snake-like pattern. The leader walks faster and faster until they are running slowly. The goal is to HOLD ON!!! Once the line breaks choose a new leader.

Mexican Piñata

Form an animal shape out of crumpled newspaper and tape. Cover the animal with strips of newspaper dipped in a paste of flour and water. Allow to dry for 48 hours. Paint with colored tempera paints. Cut an opening in the belly of the animal and fill with candy. Tape opening after you have filled the animal!!!! Get a stick, a blindfold, and have some fun!

Brazilian Brigadeiros

(Traditional Brazilian Birthday Candy)

You need:

- 2 cans Eagle Brand condensed milk
- 2 Tablespoons margarine
- 4 Tablespoons cocoa

Place all the ingredients in a pan. Cook stirring constantly over medium heat until it pulls away from sides of pan (about 20 min). Remove from heat and let cool (about 2 hours). Butter hands, roll into balls the size of large marbles and roll in sprinkles.
