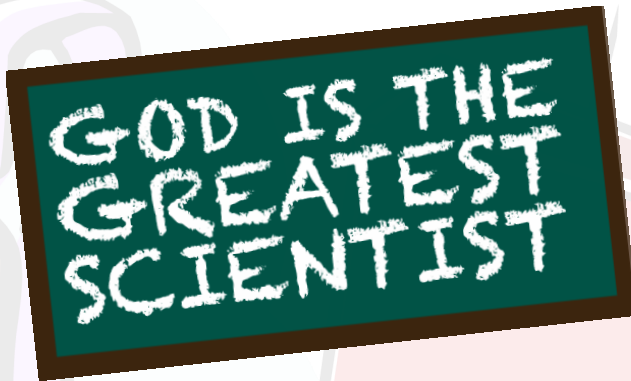

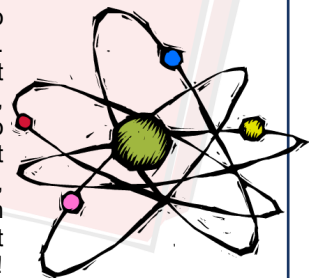
In the beginning

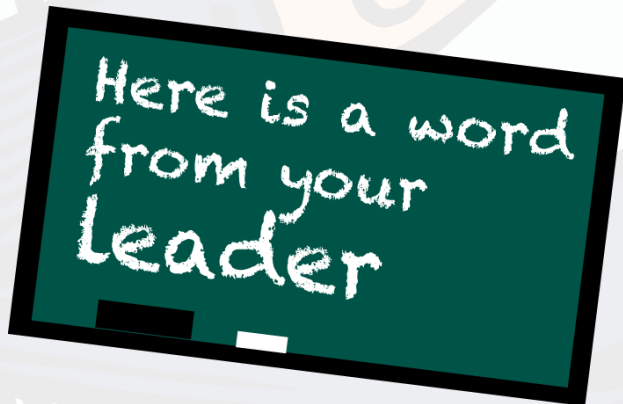
