




Spring Clean-Up May 20th 6-8pm

Work Day Tentative Project List

Church- Yard Work

Weed flower beds

Enlarge flower bed at the front of the church (left side of the walkway)

Mulch

Plant flowers

Trim bushes and trees (Especially the big pine tree lower branches)

Playground

Dig hole and sink sleeve for cross in sakrete

Stain Cross

Repair broken slat on the fence

Finish staining the fence

Thoroughly inspect the Playground / Check all bolts and screws/ boards screws etc...

Parsonage

Trim bushes

Add topsoil and re-grade front flower beds to swoop away from the building.

Mulch flower beds

Stain and repair rear side fencing

Storage Shed

Finish painting

Add shelving units inside.

Yard

Fill any pot holes(ankle snappers) in the yard with topsoil and then re-seed

High Ladder work

Clean out gutters

Wash the outside of the upper fellowship hall windows

Put the screens in the windows

Wash outside of the lower windows
