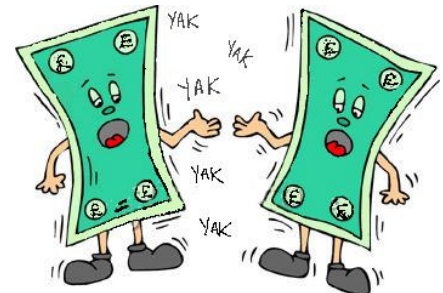

JANUARY STEWARDSHIP SERIES - MONEY TALKS

You've probably heard the phrase, "Money Talks", generally meaning that when someone brings money into the situation it changes the outcome. The money influences the circumstances in the favor of those who give it, or spend it. We recognize that money has a certain power on its own to accomplish things. Infusing money into a relationship, a problem, or an opportunity can change the direction that things go. We have also seen

money corrupt some good people, programs, and processes and lead to destructive outcomes for those not benefited. More personally we see just how powerful money is in how we make our decisions about marriage, having and raising our children, about jobs (staying in them, leaving them), and what we will attempt to try or do when money is part of the equation. God has much to say in His

Word about money. Jesus discussed this topic and used it in illustrations more than any other subset of issues. He talked about riches, about poverty, made up stories about stewardship and investing, and talked about the priority of money and things in life. The early church continued and expanded on Jesus' wisdom and elevated giving as a virtue for the first time in history.
