The crooked path of faith in the lives of believers in the Bible can give us hope that we aren't all that different from our faith heroes. The things we battle spiritually are universal. The tougher things are in fact the very things that forge the quality, purity, and strength of our faith in the long run.

We will always have the "in us, among us, and through us" faith journey challenges. We will deal with our own internal conflicts, inconsistencies, and limitations and how that gets expressed in dealing with God and others. We will struggle with how to relate to others in their similar internal realities and how that gets expressed outwardly to us and to God. And we will have to manage the accumulated effects of how we and other believers impact those around us that we hope to reach with the gospel. We have to deal with them personally AND as a group of believers living real life.
