does any of this mean to how I live, love, work, and give back?

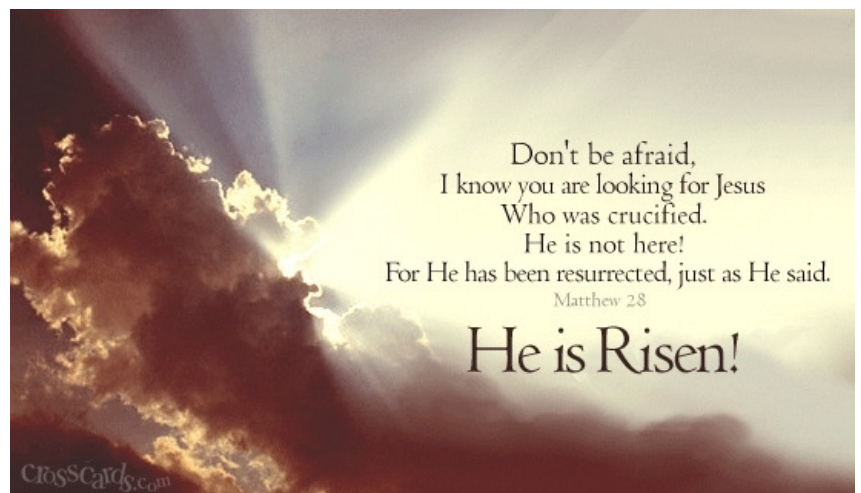
So, who do you say Jesus is?

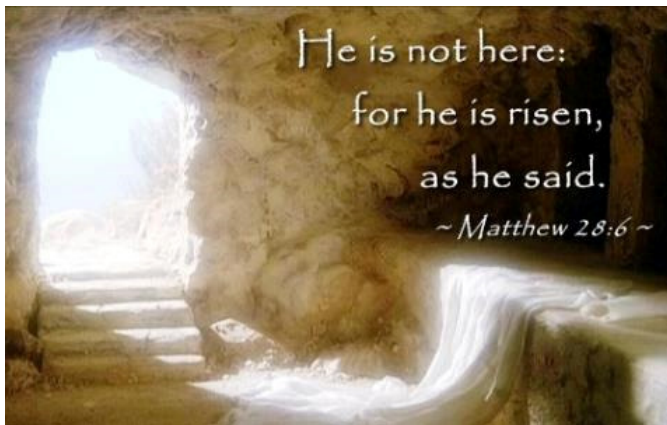

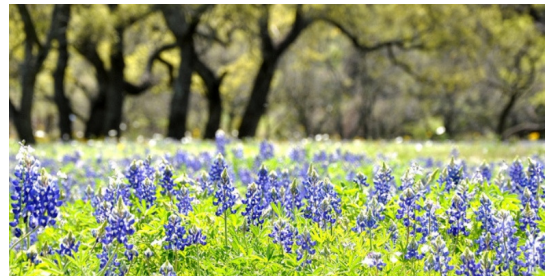
## PALM SUNDAY AND EASTER BAPTISM
