From the Minister's Desk



In Times Like These

Hebrews 12:1-4

These are the days that try the patience, the courage and, indeed, the faith of those in the church and those who are unchurched; but, in particular, the saints of God. It is amazing how we often let things, people and circumstances obscure our vision of that which we are attempting to achieve.

Are we naive enough to think that something or someone won't test our patience or our faith? Whatever befalls us, this text encourages us to keep our minds and our eyes on the prize. Faith is not something you put on and take off like an article of clothing. It is who we are, and it should be a part of the Christian fiber.

In the revelation to John and the church (chapter 2:10ptb), Jesus said this: "Be thou faithful until death, and I will give you a crown of life." To be faithful here is to adhere to every Christian tenet and not faint, give up or run when the going gets rough. We must persevere, endure and suffer long. We might suggest that the word *unto*, as given in Revelation, means we are to not let go, give in or give up - even if it means your death. We must maintain and stand firm on the whole doctrine of Christ.

In my experience, there are far too many Christians who are touchy and too sensitive. When faced with a relationship challenge, condition or situation beyond their norm, they don't know how to handle it. It is said that the time to prepare for war is in the time of peace. When Christians are practicing students of the word, constant in prayer, persistent in service and in sacrifice, they are more prepared to meet the unpleasant surprises of life than those who are tepid in spirit and lukewarm in faith.

We are to prepare for the challenges before they come. Because when the challenge hits, it is too late to go get faith. The Hebrew writer gives good, plain and powerful direction pertaining to the race of life in times like these.

1. Free yourself of any encumbrance that could hinder your forward mobility.
2. Forever exercise and maintain the saintly attribute of patience.
3. Keep your mind, your heart, your spirit, your aim, and your eyes on the cross and indeed on Jesus in times like these.
