The Church that Jesus built Matthew 16:18-19

The church, its leaders, and its members must forever preach and teach that Jesus, the anointed son of God, is the founder/builder of the church. It is a fact that many religious entities today are operating under the guise of a Christ authorized

establishment. One argument is that the name is not important, but I beg to differ with this position. A name sets people, places, and things apart one from the other, i.e., a parent giving each child a different name. Therefore, it is the name of Jesus Christ that sets His Church apart from all the rest who supposedly preach Christ.

The church was PURCHASED with the blood of the Savior (Acts 20:28). He bought it with His own blood. That being the case, He has all rights to the function and the direction of it based upon exclusive rights. When you own something, you can do whatever you please with it . The Church of Christ is to be fought for and defended. Jude, in his epistle, exhorts the saints of God to earnestly contend for "the faith" which was "once" delivered unto the saints.

Within the body of apostle Paul's letter to Titus, Paul uses language which emphasizes the uniqueness of the one church. In Titus 1:4, the expression "the common faith" is used, and in Titus 1:13 and Titus 3:15 "the faith" is used. Ephesians 4:4 states that there's "one body, and one spirit." "There is one Lord, one faith, and one baptism," Ephesians 4:5. The repeated expression of the word "the" and the word "one" helps us to understand the singular nature of the Lord's church. Romans 16:16. The church that Jesus built. This is what we must assert and defend.
