

What Our Patients Have to Say

"Who would have known that coming to Options for Women would have such a significant impact in my life? I went there just to get an ultrasound to check to see how far along this pregnancy was, as my husband and I had lost a child previously and we just wanted to see if this was a viable pregnancy. When we got there we were treated wonderfully by all the staff. After having my ultrasound done we were nervous as we still weren't sure if the pregnancy was viable yet (too early to tell). That's when we met the nurse and advocate. They took the time to talk to me and my husband about our options, and provided us with information on a ton of resources that were available if we needed them and how to contact them. I left there worried but happy to have gone.

Then I received an email. I hadn't spoken with them in months and assumed after my first visit I wouldn't be hearing from them again. But here I was staring at an email asking how I was doing. At the time my family was going through a very rough patch. I ended up very sick and was high risk. The stress alone was almost too much to bare and here I was being shown that we were not alone. From the moment I received that email, I have been in contact with the women who make Options for Wassers and the Even when

tions for Women possible. Even when my son was born 5 weeks premature and with severe health issues, they stood by my side and were there for me in prayer and in thought. This is

Community STI Testing

The CDC released a troubling report on the rates of sexually transmitted infections, and Florida and Polk County continue to show increases in the rates of infection. Because the population of 15-24 year olds showed alarming increases in infection rates and because of the dangers untreated STIs can pose to a person's reproductive health, we felt it was important to offer our free STI testing to a broader segment of the community. We have formed partnerships with local colleges and other organizations to offer our testing directly on campus, thereby removing the burden of transportation, as well as finances. Along with free testing, we have the opportunity to also counsel students on making healthier life choices in the future.

Steps to Sexual Integrity Success


We are currently serving the Farm Workers Ministry, where we meet twice a month with a group of 25 women who have been exposed to wrong concepts and experiences in sexuality. We share biblical knowledge on the subject. It has been a fantastic experience to hear how useful the information has been to them. Participants believe that this knowledge can save the next generation from the traumatic experiences they had to endure, mainly for lacking the right information. They say knowledge is power and we can testify to how empowered these women have become. By the end of February, we were also welcomed at the West Area Adult School, where we present our class to women, as well as a group of men (the first time we've done a men's course). We have been at the school for four weeks and we are already getting very good responses from participants, including sincere thanks for bringing this information. We love "the talk" - we celebrate sex and we work hard to make sure this beautiful gift is embraced the way God intended.


Thank You To Our Volunteers!
