It has become clear that our small office on Hickory Street is no longer big enough to meet the needs of our patients or staff. While the building has served the ministry well, it is time to move! Our offices are cramped and overcrowded for our growing staff and volunteers. But, most importantly, we are limited in the number of women we can serve; severely confining our ministry.



After a great deal of prayer and advice from business leaders, our Board of Directors voted to purchase a new building ! The new office, located at 4435 Florida National Drive, just off South Florida Avenue, has 2,000 square feet. This will allow us to expand the ministry of the Pregnancy Help Center and minister to hundreds more women who are at risk for abortion each year.

We were able to purchase the property at a fair price and have secured very favorable financing. Plus, with the support of some very special donors, we have already raised over \$30,000 toward our down payment!

One of the great miracles is the location of our new home, just blocks away from the abortion clinic in South Lakeland. Our ministry will be closer and more convenient, allowing us to minister more quickly and effectively to the young women who are considering abortion.

The exciting news does not stop with the purchase of a new building! We have other changes coming, that will make our ministry even more relevant to a new generation that is at risk for abortion. The goal of the Pregnancy Help Center, however, remains the same, to provide women with all the information they need to choose life. Through our dedicated volunteer counselors, medical staff and you, our supporters, we can help her make a decision for life.

Thank you for joining us on our journey! Your prayers and continued support will allow the Pregnancy Help Center to expand our reach to women at risk for abortion in the greater Lakeland area.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS MESSAGE...

“Welcome to Life” were the words spoken by President Sebastian Pinera to the 15th miner rescued, on October 13th, from the San Jose Mine in Chile. There were many profound messages throughout this world gripping event.

First, when those around him had lost hope, President Pinera was ready to do whatever was necessary to save the 33, including a plea for help from around the world. Then the message of hope, received when the miners were believed dead, through a small borehole made by rescuers. It read, “We are here and we hope that you will rescue us.”

Then, expressions of faith brought us to tears. One miner said “There were 34 of us because God was always with us.” How touching to see one man step out of the capsule onto his knees in thanksgiving to God for his rescue. The teamwork of those involved in the details of the rescue effort served to inspire the world. How proud we are as Americans that NASA designed the capsule that delivered the men from their tomb, and that an obscure company in Pennsylvania provided superior drills which expedited the rescue effort.

Providence put a man in place, employed only two months at the mine, who became the foreman. He began on day 1, to ration food, to create a day and night, to figure the talents of each of the 33 so as to assign each a meaningful job in their new workspace.

Sheer joy and jubilation took place in the hearts of all of us as we watched each of the 33 miners step out of the rescue capsule.

We too are gifted with faith as we rescue the unborn every day in the Pregnancy Help Center. We believe that God is always with us.

Because we know of your faith, we count on you to help us in our rescue efforts. We know that God has blessed you with gifts and talents. Many of you have generously shared your gifts and talents with us.

Because of you, 91% of the women we serve choose life for their unborn babies. One by one each of these little ones is born. You may not hear the cheers, sirens, nor see the confetti, but know that each time a baby is saved, we rejoice along with heaven!

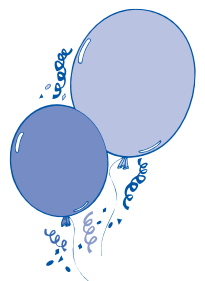

Fortunately, she did come back for a second ultrasound and brought the father with her. This is the ideal situation, for an abortion minded woman to bring the father with her for the rescan. We want the father to see the heartbeat to help him come to terms with the reality of this precious life.

Praise God that he was touched by what he saw and they were able to choose life. Tiffany is receiving all her prenatal care and moving along nicely with her pregnancy.
