A LEGACY FOR LIFE

On June 2, 2012, a group of sixty people, including past and present board members, staff, and volunteers, eagerly waited at Options for Women Pregnancy Help Clinic to surprise and celebrate Dr. Ellie Hartog. Her entry into the front lobby, her total surprise and tears, moved all to line up, and one by one speak to her of their love for her, and appreciation for her guiding force in building Options for Women into an exceptional, life saving medical facility.

Ellie had retired from her carrer as an OBGYN physician, and she wanted to help women. She was given the opportunity in 1997, when Preg-aid, the first pregnancy center in Polk County closed. Dr. Hartog, Christine Powell, Dolly Mallick, Alice Powell, Mary Wynn, Marianne Cusick, Michael Cusick, Sue Schluender, Kathleen Floyd, Mary Rutherford, Rev. Val Sheedy and Rev. John Caulfield, gathered together to plan the opening of a new center. In 1998, Ellie purchased our first office at 120 W. Hickory Street. It was remodeled by Ron Henkelman Construction. The Pregnancy Help Center of Lakeland, Inc. officially opened in October, 1998. Ellie charged

us \$1.00 for rent the first year.

In 1999, she sold the property to us for \$1.00.From the beginning, Ellie donated her expertise as a doctor and a business woman. She proved to be as devoted to the PHC as she was to her own medical practice!

Our first employee, Mary Sue Smith, served as the administrative assistant. Ellie volunteered 2-3 days a week. She enlisted members of the medical community to volunteer once a week to help our patients. Among those who helped were Dr.Jeff Puretz, Dr.Peter Alvarez, Dr.Richard Meland. From 1998-2004, Ellie served in various positions on the Board of Directors.

In January 2004, we learned that Focus on the Family was offering \$18,000 grants for ultrasound machines to Centers who agreed to complete the Medical Conversion process in four months. Dr. Hartog formed a Medical Conversion Committee to complete requirements. We qualified for the grant, and received our machine on April 27, 2004.

We officially opened as a Medical Clinic in May, 2004. Dr. Richard Rutherford served as our first Medical Director. In 2005, Dr. Jeffrey Puretz assumed this volunteer position which he currently holds. Mary Drewry was hired as the first Nurse Manager. Both Mary and Ellie provided ultrasound exams to our patients.

In February of 2006, we were alerted to a new medical service model that had a proven record for reaching abortion-minded women and impacting their decisions in favor of life. I enthusiastically shared with Ellie about the program. I told her that we would probably not be able to participate, for a lack of money. To my surprise, she offered to pay for it. The opportunity to implement this program dramatically changed the lives of many women who would have otherwise had abortions.

On November 1, 2010, we purchased and moved our present clinic. We also changed our name to Options for Women Pregnancy Help Clinic.

In May of this year, 14 years later, our first office on Hickory Street sold to Al Marshall. Again it has been purchased by a person with a great heart and passion for helping women and their unborn babies!

Ellie was presented with a special plaque which now hangs on the wall just outside of our ultrasound room. It reads: "The Dr. Ellie Hartog Ultrasound Room: Dedicated June 2012. Her Generous Heart, Devoted to Women and Babies."

"Options for Women Pregnancy Help Clinic in Lakeland is a medical clinic that performs ultrasound exams. Their mission statement is to erase the need for abortion through effectively serving pregnant at risk women by tranforming their fear into confidence.

Our society is fed a lot of lies. Here is the truth...

• From the moment of conception, a new life is formed and this new life is a person.

- When the egg is fertilized conception occurs.
- At conception a persons life begins.

• New life is a gift and is given by God. It would be against Gods plan to take away anyone's life. Thou shall not kill is the sixth commandment.

• If you stay pure until marriage then you have the freedom from worrying about

pregnancy. You don't have to worry about sexually transmitted infections either.

Frequently heard is the argument, 'It's the woman's body. It's her decision'. First, it is nonsense to suggest that the law never tells people what they can or cannot do with their bodies. In fact, there are many things which people are not legally allowed to do with their bodies. To name just a few, they cannot sell them for sex, or sell their organs to people who need transplants. Second, saying this is my body ignores the fact that, the unborn child is a separate individual from its mother. The unborn child has its own DNA code, its own fingerprints and its own blood type—none of which match the mother.(from Pro-life answers by Mark Crutcher)
