<u>James 2:13</u> ESV / For judgment is without mercy to one who has shown no mercy. Mercy triumphs over judgment.

Luke 6:36 ESV / Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful.

<u>Matthew 5:7</u> ESV / "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.

<u>Matthew 9:13</u> ESV / Go and learn what this means, 'I desire mercy, and not sacrifice.' For I came not to call the righteous, but sinners."
