His Name is Jehovah-Rapha

What does Jehovah Rapha mean?

Rapha (râpâ') means "to restore", "to heal" or "to make healthful" in Hebrew. When the two words are combined – Jehovah Rapha – it can be translated as "Jehovah Who Heals." Jehovah is the Great Physician who heals the physical and emotional needs of His people

14 And when they were come to the multitude, there came to him a certain man, kneeling down to him, and saying,

15 Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is lunatick, and sore vexed: for ofttimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water.

16 And I brought him to thy disciples, and they could not cure him.

When the man came to Jesus what was important about him kneeling down?

17 Then Jesus answered and said, O faithless and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer you? bring him hither to me.

18 And Jesus rebuked the devil; and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour.

Why did Jesus call them faithless and perverse?

What happens when your faith is weaken by a situation?

Does Jesus become frustrated? Why?

19 Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out?

20 And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

21 Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting.

What is the significance of fasting and praying?

Does fasting and praying invite the Holy Spirit into our situation?
