I WAS ONCE BLIND JOHN 9:1-12 "A PARADIGM SHIFT" (PART 1)

Paradigms are generally defined as a framework that has unwritten rules and that directs actions. A paradigm shift occurs when one paradigm loses its influence and another takes over.

- 1 Now as Jesus passed by, He saw a man who was blind from birth.
- 2 And His disciples asked Him, saying, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?"
- 3 Jesus answered, "Neither this man nor his parents sinned, but that the works of God should be revealed in him.
- 4 I[a] must work the works of Him who sent Me while it is day; the night is coming when no one can work.

The blind man's condition was chosen by God to declare his glory.

- Have you every experienced having a difficult situation where God used it to reveal His glory?
- What did it feel like going through the experience?
- How has it prepared you to trust God in all situations?

5 As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world."

- 6 When He had said these things, He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva; and He anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay.
- 7 And He said to him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam" (which is translated, Sent). So he went and washed, and came back seeing.

- We see how Jesus spat on the ground and made mud and told the man to go and wash himself:
- To what extent are you willing to do as God has instructed you?
- We say we trust God but when He gives us strange instructions why do we struggle?

- 8 Therefore the neighbors and those who previously had seen that he was [b]blind said, "Is not this he who sat and begged?"
- 9 Some said, "This is he." Others said, [c]"He is like him." He said, "I am he."
- 10 Therefore they said to him, "How were your eyes opened?"
