Dual enrollment is available through Sevenstar On-line Academy, Grand Canyon University and locally at Cape Cod Community College. Seniors will participate in a Senior Thesis research project.

Trinity Christian Academy graduates have a 100% acceptance rate into the colleges of their choice. Graduates have been awarded many scholarships and grants as well as merit based scholarships from independent organizations.



CREATIVE & STUDIO ARTS

High School Art classes include: Foundations 1 & 2, Art 3 & 4. Both courses have two or more Studio Art
