# TCA ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT

The Trinity Christian Academy of Cape Cod (TCA) Development Office recently caught up with Trinity alumna, Jody Hassett-Sanchez. Jody was an elementary student during the early years of TCA and attended from 1970-1974. She is the president of Pointy Shoe Productions

(PSP), a documentary and long-form production company that explores issues of faith and culture.

Before becoming a filmmaker, Jody spent 17 years in network television, most recently at ABC. She covered religion, culture, and education for ABC's World News Tonight with Peter Jennings, and stories for Nightline. Prior to ABC News, Jody traveled the globe with CNN for almost twelve years. As the State Department producer covering Secretary of State, Madeleine Albright, Jody was a senior producer of CNN's series on the legacy of the Cold War and was an arts reporter for CNN International. Her honors include an Edward R. Murrow Award, a National Emmy Award, USC Getty Annenburg Fellowship for Journalism in the Arts, and Journalistes en Europe Fellowship. (www.widmeyer.com)

"Although I spent many years as a news producer at CNN and then at ABC World News Tonight, I've never been enchanted by Washington DC's 'chattering class' who want to parse the past 24 hours. Perhaps that's because years ago, I was introduced to what Mortimer Adler calls the "Great Conversation" while I was a student at Trinity.

"Trinity Christian Academy teachers and classes gave me a taste of that ongoing conversation of great minds through the ages, framing it in the important context of scripture. This approach has informed my reporting and documentary filmmaking throughout my career. I'm able to view current events through the lens of the past and I try to frame my interview questions in a way that advances the discussion rather than just adding to the noise.

"Having the assurance that we are loved by a God who is not the author of confusion but of peace, has guided me through conflict zones and heartbreaking interviews with the victims of slavery and other brutalities. I am indebted to my foundational years at Trinity and particularly thankful for the faithfulness and the intellectual vigor of Helen MacGregor, who selected each book and every concept we studied during my years at Trinity."

As a graduate of Smith College and a native Cape Codder, Jody lives in the Washington, DC area with her husband George Sanchez. Her web site is jodyhassettsanchez.com.

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

Since Brandon Heath's debut on Reunion Records with "Don't Get Comfortable" (2006), he has become one of Christian music's most beloved and respected artists and songwriters. Heath has garnered an Emmy Award, five GRAMMY® nominations and an American Music Award nomination.

He has been honored as a seven time GMA Dove Award recipient, including "Male Vocalist of the Year" (2009 and 2010), BMI's 2014 Songwriter of the Year, and earned multiple additional songwriting honors. His award winning songs and signature vocals reflect a soaring radio career that includes top hits "I'm Not Who I Was," "Wait and See," the 2009 GMA Dove Award winning Song of the Year "Give Me Your Eyes," the eight week chart topper, "Your Love," "The Light In Me," and many others.

Heath, a Nashville native, first began writing at age 13. His artistry and ability to connect with audiences have compelled countless media outlets across the nation to platform his story and music.
