1 Where were you when you heard of the attacks on 9/11? How would you describe the buzz in your community? What noticeable changes occurred at that time? Do they still exist?

2 In Psalm 85:1-5, what seems to cause the writer to look back to how things used to be? Is he looking for a return to the glory years, or is he remembering the mercies of God? What do we tend to do? Is there a difference?

3 Individual psalms are typically viewed as 'stand alone', unrelated to the psalm before or after. To better understand Psalm 85 take a closer look at Psalm 84 and 86.

- How does Psalm 86 expand upon the themes of Psalm 85?

4 The phrases used in Psalm 85:10-13 are in a context of partnership, not opposition. We tend to view them as opposites. What difference does it make? What is God asking you to do to bring about the hug & kiss of verse 10 in each of your relationships? Will you follow His lead (12) in this partnership?
