#### OUR GUEST PREACHER: REV. THEODORE TURMAN - 7:30am



Rev. Theodore Thomas Turman is a native of Detroit MI and a product of the Detroit Public School system. In May of 2006, Rev. Turman graduated from Tuskegee University with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in English. He received his Master of Divinity degree from the Candler School of Theology at Emory University in 2009. He is currently pursuing his Doctor of Ministry degree from the Boston University School of Theology.

Rev. Turman is also a product of the Second Baptist Church of Detroit. He has been active in both the Progressive National Baptist Convention and American Baptist Churches-USA. He was licensed by Second Baptist in 2005 and was ordained in 2011 through both the ABC-USA and PNBC. He has served as a Community Organizer with The Detroit-African American Leadership Council and with Atlantans Building Leadership for Empowerment, organizing youth around issues of social justice.

From 2007 to 2009, Rev. Turman served as the Youth Pastor of First Iconium Baptist Church of Atlanta GA, under the pastorate of Rev. Timothy McDonald III. He has served as a Staff Chaplain with Hospice Atlanta, DeKalb Medical Center, and Children's Healthcare of Atlanta, where he completed his CPE Internship and Residency.

In October of 2014, Rev. Turman was elected as the 33<sup>rd</sup> pastor of the First Baptist Church of Detroit; the first African-American pastor in the church's 190-year history. Rev. Turman is married to the former Akilah Fatima Dozier and they are the proud parents of Gavin Christopher Turman.


