FROM THE DESK OF REV. CARNEL RICHARDSON

Beloved of God,

"Blessed are the Poor in Spirit, for Theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven" Matthew 5:3

The poor in spirit are those who rely totally upon the grace, mercy, and provision of God for their survival. In his gospel, St. Matthew spiritualizes the reality that the poor are constantly blessed by the mighty hand of God. Our heavenly Father hears the cries of the poor. When the Israelites cried out to the Lord concerning their oppressed condition, he provided a deliverer (Exodus 3:7-8).

The needy, broken, lost, crippled, depressed, distressed, and outcast are all granted access to the kingdom of Heaven in spite of spiritual poverty. Whether they are physically poor or not does not justify their ultimate need for God's tender mercies. The beatitude, "Blessed are the Poor in Spirit, for Theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven," drives home the point that one of the keys to the Kingdom is humility and total dependence upon God for everything. Furthermore, the church itself must adopt the posture found in Matthew 5:3 in order to show society that the church is the acting agent of God's concern for mercy and justice for all.


