God has claimed us and we have to respond. We come to praise our Creator, to listen to God's Word and to set our hopes on things that matter.



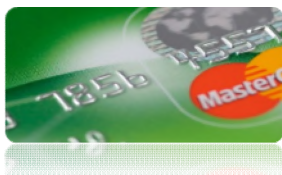
Offertory Prayer

"Prior to the 20th century, most African American Christian women commonly followed 1 Corinthians 11:6 and covered their heads in worship. For early African Americans, God's house was not only a sanctuary of hope and salvation in a brutal world, but it was also one of the few places where they were allowed to hold important positions of leadership. Sunday was thus a day of worship and celebration. African American women traded in their drab aprons and knotted head wraps for brightly colored dresses and straw hats decorated with fresh flowers, ribbons and feathers. These heaven-reaching hats were designed to "catch God's eye" in hopes He would hear their prayers."
