This course is designed for  
anyone who desires to in-  
crease their knowledge of  
individual (one-on-one) cri-  
sis intervention techniques  
in the fields of Employee  
Assistance, Law Enforce-  
ment, Fire, Chaplaincy,  
Mental Health, Disaster Re-  
sponse and Military.  
Crisis Intervention is  
NOT psychotherapy;  
rather, it is a specialized  
acute emergency mental  
health intervention  
which requires special-  
ized training. As physical  
first aid is to surgery,  
crisis intervention is to  
psychotherapy. Thus,  
crisis intervention is  
sometimes called  
"emotional first aid".  
This program is designed  
for teaching participants  
the fundamentals of, and  
a specific protocol for,
