SUMC FINANCIAL UPDATE:

Eleven (11) months into the fiscal year which began on July 1st, things continue to go well.

<u>General Operations</u> – Income is right at the budgeted level (0.5% over the 11-month budget). Expenses are 2.6% below the 11-month budget. This leaves a very small surplus of \$3,835.

Sanctuary Renovation – Sanctuary renovation pledges received during this 11-month period have allowed us to make scheduled mortgage payments. The total amount owed at the end of May was \$125,990 which is one month into the final year of the initial 3-year pledges.

BUDGET UPDATE: Completion of the budget for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 has been put on hold until a better estimate of income can be made.

<u>**Gifts**</u> – Pledges have been received from 72 out of 270 households. In order to contact the households who have not responded, an e-mail will be sent to those with an e-mail address on file at the church and letters will be sent to the others. Responses are due by June 30^{th} .
