

Music time:

Music time is the first thing we do when the kids arrive and Pastor Eric does a great job of getting them moving and singing!

Goals:

WOW is an after school program for grades 1-5 held on Wednesdays. All children in the community are welcome. Kindergarten students can attend if they have an older sibling attending and the parents feel their kindergartner is ready for this experience. WOW includes snacks, music, games, Bible stories, prayer, and crafts.

WOW is in place to help children further develop and deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ, strengthen their faith, and encourage them to share that faith in Jesus with others. The WOW program is a safe, encouraging, positive place for elementary children to be Wednesdays after school.

Bussing:

Free bussing is available for Central Elem. students.

Students who go to other schools are encouraged to attend WOW, but need to work out their own transportation.

Absences:

When the WOW bus arrives we take attendance to make sure we have everyone. Therefore, **we need parents to contact All Saints if their child will be absent from WOW**, just as they would contact the school to report an absence.

WOW fee:

The fee for the whole year is \$36 per child. You can pay the fee in full at time of registration or pay \$18 at time of registration and \$18 in January. Scholarships are available. Please talk to Pastor Eric or Christin Fugate.

Registration Form:

The enclosed registration form must be completed for your child. Or you can go online to fill it out and pay the fee. A new form is required each year.

Time frame:

The children arrive at the church about 3:00 p.m. WOW lasts until 4:30 p.m. Parents must come into the church building and down to the fellowship hall to pick up their children. Children will not be released to find their parents.
