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What's Happened Since July...

- Initial drawings have been completed and are under review by the city
- Once complete, Miller will be ready to start detailed design phase
- •We paid off our current mortgage!
- Currently saving \$3,000 per month to put towards the new building



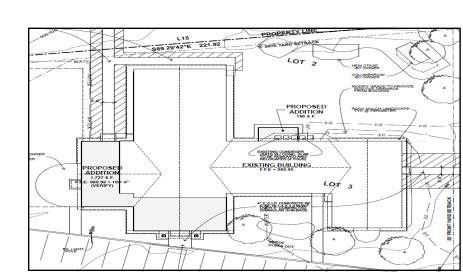


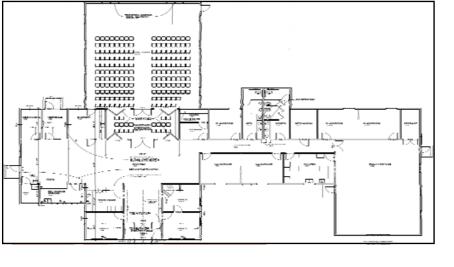
Reviewing Phase 1 Highlights

- Specific exterior improvements include
- New insulation, siding, windows, doors, soffit, gutters and fascia.
- Specific interior improvements include
- Expanding the gathering space and bathrooms, moving the offices, new ceilings, flooring, fire protection, lighting, heating and cooling systems, painting and other repairs as needed to give All Saints a modern interior.

Origin of Phase 1 Project

- •As detailed in the June 5th letter, the Building and Grounds ministry team conducted an assessment of our current facility
- •Results showed that many areas of the building needed immediate attention
- New furnaces and AC
- Windows
- · Siding, facia, soffit, gutters
- Fix heaving sidewalks at building entry
- Repair/create drainage around building
- •Phase 1 addresses both the immediate needs and supports future growth





Project Requirements

•There are two pathways to building the new church: Planning Efforts and Financial Support



 This entails the work the building teams and council is undertaking with Miller (e.g., drawings, bids, permits...)

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Phase 1 Financial Requirements

- Following the successful completion of the bidding process (~Feb. 2018), final application will be made with the Mission Investment Fund (MIF)
- Approval from MIF is contingent on the congregation fulfilling the financial requirements
- •The congregation must meet the following three requirements
- Maintain a balanced operating budget in 2017
 Maintain monthly Daring Faith building fund contributions of at least \$10,000
- 3. Reduce/eliminate our budget deficit in the Mission and Ministry fund

Call to Action "Maintain a balanced operating budget in 2017"

- Adjusting the fiscal calendar
- Enables informed decisions based on pledged financial support
- Continue to encourage every member to contribute to the church -Mission and Ministry fund
- Tell our story
- Reiterate the importance of fulfilling a pledge
- Inform all families that we are striving to make giving as convenient as possible
- Electronic giving through All Saints website
- Smartphone giving app
- Texting
- Onsite card reader
- Your bank's bill pay service

Fulfillment of MIF Requirement 1 "Maintain a balanced operating budget in 2017"

- •For 2017, the Operating Budget is \$24,351 behind
- •Having deficits throughout the year limits our ministry
- •To meet this first requirement, everyone needs to take action

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Fulfillment of MIF Requirement 2 "Monthly capital fund contributions of at least \$10,000"

- Average giving to Daring Faith fund has been \$12,000
- •The more that is given before we break ground the smaller our loan will be
- •Estimated monthly payments for a \$1.1 million dollar loan will be \$7,500
- Estimated building fund balance at completion of project will be \$200,000

Note: Phase 1 estimate is from Miller and assumes today's market conditions will not drastically change next spring

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Call to Action - Fulfillment of MIF Requirement 2 "Monthly capital fund contributions of at least \$10,000"

- We highly encourage you to fulfill your pledge or continue to contribute your unpledged gifts
- We will continue to save money whenever possible
- E.g., getting new shed donated, saving enough money on roof to pay for entire parking lot project...





Fulfillment of MIF Requirement 3 "Reduce/eliminate our budget deficit"

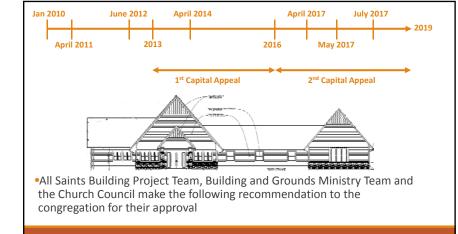
- •The deficit is what the Mission and Ministry fund owes the Daring Faith building fund and the Saving fund
- Our current deficit is \$59.000
- Daring Faith: \$24,350 from 2017 and \$24,500 from previous years
- Savings: \$10,150 from 2007
- •We have challenges ahead of us, but together we can make this happen

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Resolution 1 Complete Detailed Design Drawings for Phase 1

- Be it Resolved
- That the congregation approve the next steps with its partner,
 Miller Architects & Builders to:
- Complete construction drawings for the approved project and complete the competitive bidding process at a cost of \$80,748
- (Pre-Construction Fee Balance: \$6,050 and Architectural Fees: \$74,698)
- Open discussion regarding Resolution 1
