THE NEW BUILDING BLOG: (Update on the progress of the New Building/Remodel Project.)

After almost 7 years of working on the building project, 2018 looks like the year for all the planning and designing to become a reality for All Saints Lutheran. The plans are near completion. Colors and materials have been picked. The specifications for the bids are being written. The project is moving forward at a fast pace.

With all that has been completed, there is a lot that will still needs to happen before the projects starts. The following is a timeline of the project that takes us from today, to the start of construction.

Jan. 22, 2018:	All color selections are finalized, (wood, stain color, paint colors, partitions, fixtures, carpet, etc.).
Jan. 23 - Feb. 11th, 2018:	Miller Architects finalizes plans, specifications and bidding documents.
Jan. 23 - March 1, 2018:	New Building Group to finalize building components not handled by Miller Architects. (Audio/visual, signage, specialty lighting).
Feb.12, 2018:	Miller Architects releases All Saints Luther Remodel Project for bid to contractors.
March 1, 2018:	Contractors bids due to Miller Architects.
March 4, 2018:	Announcement of the Congregational Meeting on March 18th, 2018 for the vote to move forward with the building project.
March 13, 2018:	Miller Architects to present bid results and make recommendations to the New Building Committee.
March 15, 2018:	Church Council to hold a special meeting. New Building committee will review the bids from Miller Architects and make recommendations to the council.
March 18, 2018:	Congregational Meeting to be held. New Building and Church Council to present the bids and make recommendations to the congregation to proceed with the project. Congregation to vote (yes or no) to moving forward with the project.

April 8, 2018:	Confirmation Sunday at All Saints.
April 9-14, 2018:	Building Move out.
April 15, 2018:	Special Church Service with ground breaking ceremony.
April 16, 2018:	Miller personnel take over building and construction begins.
