Dear Friends,

I hope you pick up our free daily devotional "The Word in Season" available outside our office. The devotional has a Bible passage and brief meditation and prayer for each day. Here is an edited version of Monday's devotional:

"He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and will not despise their prayer. (Psalm 102:17)

Destitute, poor, impoverished, needy, underprivileged, God listens to these. That's not to say that God doesn't listen to all prayers, but there is something special about the prayers that come from those who have nothing.

This past January marked the fourth anniversary of my daughter's attempted suicide. She was nearly 13 years old when she took 132 sleeping pills in the hope of not waking up. I was the one who found her and cradled her in my arms while waiting for the paramedics to arrive. I still can't imagine all that she was going through, all that was dragging her into her own depths of despair. What I do know is that this turned into a very dark time for me and for the rest of my family. In this darkness, I felt the poverty of spirit reflected in today's reading.

You have probably experienced something like this. A time when your spirit was destitute, when you couldn't find hope, when darkness was the norm of life. God listens to us deeply in our dark times. Maybe even more deeply than at other times. God hears your prayers, in the good and bad times, whether you feel it or not.

God, listen to my prayers from my own darkness. Help me to feel your presence in my despair. Amen.
