Job Description

Worship faithfully, spend time in the Bible and prayer as you support the mission of All Saints as we Celebrate Grace, Make Disciples and Make a Difference

Pray for All Saints—its children, youth, families and staff.

Facilitate and coordinate leaders and volunteers to support the Children, Youth and Family programs

Work with Learning Team and Youth and Family Team to coordinate activities, acquire support materials and manage team projects.

Continue All Saint's strong tradition of Children, Youth and Family programs and contribute new ideas to revamp, strengthen and grow Children, Youth, and Family programs.

Provide information to Children, Middle School, Senior High, Parents, Congregation & staff through website, Facebook, email, church bulletin or other media.

Preach twice a year sharing with the congregation God's vision for All Saint's Children, Youth and Family ministry.

Work collaboratively with staff, attend staff meetings and take guidance from Lead Pastor.

Average 40 hours per week with emphasis on Wednesdays (day and evening) and Sunday mornings and as necessary to meet other programming needs.

Children- Age 0-Grade 5

1. Provide structure and support for: Sunday School, Word on Wednesday (WOW) after school program and Vacation Bible School.
2. Recruit, train and support disciples needed for Children's Ministry.
3. Coordinate Sunday School Christmas program and various Sunday morning activities.
4. Coordinate Welcome to Sunday School, Bible 101, First Communion, Lord's Prayer and other Remember the Promise celebrations.
5. Coordinate Children and Family events.

Middle School-Grade 6-8–Confirmation

1. Review curriculum for three year program and choose lessons
2. Recruit, train, and support small group guides
3. Teach large group lessons and lead retreat
4. Coordinate Middle School and Family Events

Senior High Grade 9-12

1. Coordinate and teach Sacred Blend –Monthly Bible Study
2. Coordinate and attend ELCA National Youth Gathering Event and/or other mission and retreat events.
3. Coordinate High School and Family Events
4. Support Youth in their community and school activities
