Letter from the Executive Director

ULTRASOUNDS AND MAKING A DIFFERENCE

Compassion has performed limited ultrasounds since 2010. We felt some growing pains in 2013 and into 2014 as an increased number of abortion-determined women came into our center. God gave us a vision of having a separate, updated medical wing in which we could minister to women contemplating abortion. This vision moved closer to reality when the Knights of Columbus from St. John Vianney approached Compassion earlier this year about fundraising for a capital project at our center. After raising \$6,200 through a baby bottle campaign in their church, the Knights began construction on September 8th. Ten days later they presented us with a completely updated medical wing. This new wing offers clients waiting for an ultrasound a private entrance and lobby. The new layout gives clients much-needed confidentiality and an effective flow for our volunteer nurses.

Our new wing opened with a new ultrasound machine thanks to the generosity of Trinity Lutheran Church, Clinton Township. The church blessed us in August with a new machine when they learned our original machine was consistently operating improperly.

Why is our focus on abortion determined women? According to the Guttmacher Institute "abortion is a common experience: At current rates, about one in three American women will have had an abortion by the time she reaches age 45." Abortion even affects women of faith as Guttmacher also reports that 73% of women seeking an abortion report a religious affiliation."

Does an ultrasound make a difference in a women's decision to choose life? That depends on the study you choose to read and believe. A recent Internet search revealed the success rates of ultrasound programs range from 7.4% (© 2014 by The American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists.) to 90% (National Knights of Columbus). Even if you believe that ultrasounds made a difference only 7.4% of the time, ultrasounds could have saved

3,996,000 babies since abortion was legalized in 1973.

The decision for a woman to have an abortion depends on many factors: her relationships, finances, housing, schooling, resources, and in some cases, how far along she is in her pregnancy. In Michigan, abortion providers are not mandated to perform an ultrasound before the procedure, failing to give women all the information they need to make fully informed choices about their pregnancies. An ultrasound is definitely one of those resources that present the visual truth of new life and in many times, yes, is a factor.

A limited ultrasound can determine that a pregnancy is viable, meaning the baby has a heartbeat and is in the woman's uterus. It can also determine the baby's approximate age. We have saved women from the pain of an unnecessary abortion because the FREE ultrasound she received at Compassion revealed a nonviable pregnancy. According to the American Pregnancy Association, up to 1 in 4 women miscarry. We are able to offer a woman who may be miscarrying an ear to listen and compassion.

A woman has the right to be provided factual information about her options in a non-judgmental, compassionate environment. The decision she is faced with is often stressful and carries consequences. That's why you as our supporters and volunteers are so very special to this ministry. Our doors remain open and our services remain free because you care and support life.

We are now just a few weeks into our new medical wing and the comments are overwhelmingly positive by those that use and give our services.

We give thanks to all of those that gave of their time, talent and treasures to make this update possible. We could not be more grateful to have exactly what we need to end abortion in our community.
