

The activities below will help your children remember and apply the lesson they learned this week. Plan some time to do each of these together as a family.

BIBLE STORY: EXODUS 2:1-10

This week, we learned about Adam and Eve's family. Each of us is part of a family. Read the Bible Story in Genesis 2:4-24; 4:1-2 together. Talk about the members of Adam and Eve's family then talk about who is in your family.

ACTIVITY 1: ME PANCAKES

Help your child understand that each person is part of your family. Everyone in the family can make a Me pancake. Make large pancakes for breakfast. Have everyone in the family decorate their pancake to look like themselves. You can use a variety of toppings to make the faces - fruit, whipped cream, chocolate chips, anything you have in your pantry. Line up all the Me pancakes and tell your child that they are part of the family. Talk about each member of the family and remind your child that God Gave Me My Family.

ACTIVITY 2: PLANNING THE DAY

Put together a box and designate it the "Family Mailbox." Have everyone make cards or gifts to put in the mailbox throughout the week (you can set aside a place for everyone to make their cards/letters/gifts and supply it with the necessary supplies). Pick one night out the week to be mail night. Distribute the mail and talk about how giving mail to each other is showing love because God Gave Me My Family.

Lesson 2

Use the pictures and text below to retell the Bible Story to your children. Some questions and answers are included to help you gauge their remembrance and understanding of the story.



Who does the Bible tell us was the first man created? (*Adam.*)

The Bible tells us that Adam was the first man God created. Adam worked in the garden and took care of all the animals God created. Adam was all alone, so one day God told Adam He would make a helper for Adam.



God put Adam to sleep so He could make Eve. God took a rib from Adam's body and made another person.



Were Adam and Eve a family? (*Yes.*)

God gave Eve to Adam to be his helper. They were a family. Eve would help Adam do his work in the garden and take care of the animals with him.



What were the names of Adam and Eve's children? (*Cain, Abel, and Seth.*)

Adam and Eve's family grew.

They had three sons named: Cain, Abel, and Seth.

Just like God gave Adam a family, He also give us a family. Our family loves us, cares for us, and helps us.
