

The activities below will help your children remember and apply the lesson they learned this week. Plan some time to do each of these together as a family.

**BIBLE STORY:
GENESIS 12:1-9,
GALATIANS 3:9, 14**

Read the story of Abraham's Blessing in Genesis 12:1-9 and Galatians 3:9, 14. Talk about how God was good to Abraham so that Abraham could be good to others. Talk about some of the ways that God has been good to your family and then think of some ways you can be good to someone else.

ACTIVITY 1: PAY IT FORWARD

Think of someone that you want to be good to this week. It might be a friend or a relative or even someone you don't know well like your mail carrier. Decide what you want to do for that person and work together with your child to do it. Remind your child that God has been good to us so this is a way for us to be good to someone else.

ACTIVITY 2: VOLUNTEER TOGETHER

Find an opportunity where your whole family can serve together. Prior to serving talk to your children about the ways God had been good to your family. Remind them that because God has been good to your family, you want to be good to other people as well. The serving opportunity is one way to share God's goodness with others you don't know.

Lesson 7

Use the pictures and text below to retell the Bible Story to your children. Some questions and answers are included to help you gauge their remembrance and understanding of the story.



Did Abraham learn that he should be good to others? (Yes.)

There was a man named Abraham who lived a long time ago. Abraham learned that God was good to him, so he should be good to others. Abraham and his family lived in a land called Haran.



One day, God spoke to Abraham and told him that He wanted Abraham to move with his family to a new land. God gave Abraham a promise for his future though.



Was God good to Abraham so he could be good to others? (Yes.)

God told Abraham that all the families on the earth could be blessed through Abraham. God would be good to Abraham and through Abraham, He would be good to others.



God told Abraham that he would be a great nation. That meant that Abraham would have lots of people in his family. God would be good to all the people in Abraham's just like He was good to Abraham. Because God was good to Abraham, we know that God will also be good to us. Because God is good to us, we should be good to others. You can be good to others by being their friend, helping them, or even by giving them things.
