## Special Opportunities for Giving

***Contributions to these funds can be made at any time by simply notating the fund name on the "Memo" line of your check.***

- ◆ **NC4 Scholarship Fund**—These funds provide assistance for tuition, books and other college fees for our graduating high-school seniors as they move into college.
- ◆ **Patrons of the Arts Fund**—Your gifts to this fund help pay for special musicians (such as our jazz worship musicians), visual artists, and other artistic events for worship and the general fellowship of the church and community.
- ◆ **Minister's Discretionary Fund**—Contributions to the Minister's Discretionary Fund are used to assist those members of the church who may be experiencing a severe financial crises in their lives. The Minister, in consultation with our Elders, uses this fund to help meet specific needs of the individual or family.
- ◆ **Adult/Youth Mission Trips**— As indicated above, our Youth spend time each summer in a mission project, and your contributions help them do that. Our Adults as well seek out opportunities to do hands-on work in mission (such as the Tuscaloosa Mission trip and Habitat for Humanity projects). These contributions make this mission work possible.
- ◆ **Praying Hands Knitting Ministry**— Several of our members take their time to knit baby caps and lap robes and shawls that they bless with prayer to give to those who need a little extra warmth and comfort — your contributions help buy the yarn and materials used.
