Local Tornado Response – BDM continues to meet with the Long Term Recovery Group and Volunteer Coordination Committee. With our partners we've prepared homes for winter and delivered furniture. Trainings have been held for assessors and estimators. Case managers have been hired, but more are needed. Volunteer opportunities are posted on MVStrong.org. Please go there to learn of opportunities and to register to help.

Project Updates – Our newest site, Jacksonville, FL, will be open until mid-December, and will then relocate to the Tampa, FL area. The Tampa site is scheduled to be open January 12, 2020 through April 4, 2020. Work will continue in Lumberton, NC through April 2020. The site in Castaner, Puerto Rico has been extended through May 2020.

2020 Trips – The 2020 trip schedule is posted on the website. The January 19 – 25 and February 9 – 15 trips are to Lumberton, NC, where BDM is working on recovery from Hurricane Matthew (2016) and Hurricane Florence (2018).
