Visitors are encouraged to make a canned food donation or a monetary donation (for the church's youth programming and Good Samaritan fund). Masks and social distancing are required for this outdoor event.

Southern Ohio/Kentucky Disaster Ministries Updates:

Dayton BDM Site – Due to the high rate of COVID-19, the Dayton BDM site is not currently accepting volunteers. The BDM leaders are finishing up the current jobs and will not take on any new work. The site will be paused until the beginning of April. Groups are then scheduled for the remainder of 2021. Much of the work has been removing damaged siding and roofs, and then residing and reroofing the houses. There is also a new build that BDM and Habitat for Humanity are working on together.

2021 Trip Schedule – Monthly BDM trips are scheduled for 2021. In January, February, and March our crews will be working in Bayboro, NC. April through the remainder of the year, we anticipate working in Dayton, OH. Due to the COVID-19 environment, we have committed to a half crew which is six volunteers. If we have more than six who wish to serve, we'll check to see if other slots are available. COVID-19 procedures are in place during travel, at the housing site, and at the work site. BDM works hard at serving disaster survivors and keeping volunteers safe.
