Missional Renewal met on 6/9/21 & 7/5/21

- We discussed and approved "Questions for Considering the New Normal". (This document is page 2 of this report.)
 - These questions are for the purpose of helping leadership and congregations as they move forward into a post-pandemic context.

- We discussed and approved our "narrative" to be submitted to the Resource Development Commission. (Our narrative follows below.)
 - Missional Renewal Commission Narrative: The Missional Renewal Commission's purpose is to help congregations become more missional within their communities. We do this by offering resources and guidance to help congregations reach out more effectively. We also offer our support and encouragement to congregations as they seek renewal through finding new ways of being Jesus' ambassadors in the neighborhood.

What is the Spirit doing in our lives as followers of Jesus?
