As of September 1, 2013 our lease agreement with Robin Waddell comes to an end and we will again have full responsibility of the camp facility at Woodland Altars. A transitional team has been appointed by the District Board to provide leadership as we move forward with this effort. Architect Gerald Harley has begun assessing maintenance needs and cost of repairs at the facility and will present a full report to District Conference this October.

As of 01 September 2013, the Transition Team decided to:

- -close Heritage Lodge, Sugar Grove Lodge, the ranch house, the farm house, and the three modulars pending the final report from Gerald Harley.
- -keep the chalets open after the wood-burning stoves are inspected, the water is tested, the locks are changed, and the fire extinguishers, smoke and carbon monoxide detectors are checked.
- -Tom and Karen Dillon have been assigned to see that the tasks for the chalets are completed.
 - -hire Vonda Jones as part-time caretaker for Woodland Altars.
- -have Justin Sawin stay in a chalet and provide a physical presence on the property in exchange for a waiver of the rental fee.
