- Answering a concern from the Eaton Church concerning recent decisions and/or actions by various denominational agencies, departments, committees and educational institutions of the Church of the Brethren that are in conflict with the 1983 Annual Conference paper on Human Sexuality. A specific example sited was booth space provided at Annual Conference to the Brethren Mennonite Council for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender Interests. We then moved to an inspiring worship with a great message from moderator Julie Hostetetter where we were encouraged to remember our baptism.

- Reports from various commissions
- Consideration of a proposal from the Brookville Church to make a change to the District Code of Regulations. This proposal was not accepted.
- Approval of the 2014 budget.
