Brethren Disaster Ministry Updates

Thank you to the S. Ohio District churches for your tremendous support of Brethren Disaster Ministries during 2013. We sent 131 volunteers on fourteen trips to Indiana, New York and New Jersey to repair and rebuild homes. We also assembled and shipped to Church World Service 34 baby kits, 170 school kits, 178 hygiene kits, and 600 clean up buckets. All of these will be distributed to disaster survivors. In a tangible way, our district has shared God's love with those in need.

⇒ Church World Service Clean Up Bucket Kits: Southern Ohio BDM plans to assemble 500 Buckets at Eaton Church of the Brethren (Barron St. Location) on Tuesday, April 29th at 7:00 P.M. In order to meet this goal it will cost approximately \$30,000. These units meet critical need in times of disaster. S. Ohio individuals, churches and groups have been faithful to support this effort and we look forward to a time of fellowship as we move forward with this important outreach.
