Before I come to the office in the mornings I stop by the Mc Donald's on Nederland Avenue. I handover my \$1.08 and Linda behind the counter gives me a 32 ounce McDonald's cup, a straw, and I fill it with Diet Coke and a splash of Dr. Pepper.

I settle into a chair and begin to talk to the dozen or so regulars who are sipping their coffee and going over the headlines in the Port Arthur News. Just about everyday it is the same dozen or so retirees who chew the fat and poke fun at one another. But one thing I have noticed is that these people really do care for one another.

A few weeks ago one of the retiree's had a funeral for his wife of 53 years. The group pitched in for a floral display and a memorial donation.

Privately I approached Mr. Reasons and offered him my condolences, "Sir I am sorry for the loss of your wife." Mr. Reasons looked at me, smiled over his cup of coffee, and said in his Louisianan African American brogue, "Chief," (he always calls me Chief), "Chief, I haven't lost her, I know exactly where she is! She is with Jesus!"

Such faith shared over a cup of coffee!

To some his statement may seem rather bold or a bit flippant. With so many after-death theories in the world of 2014, one might wonder how one can really be sure where our loved ones go after death. Yet as Christians we have confidence and assurance from the Word of the Lord. It is based on the historic reality that Jesus came and died to cancel our penalty from sin so that we may receive eternal life. Since Christ Jesus rose from the grave we too shall not be hindered from heaven. The Lord reminded His disciples and us that He is preparing a place for us.

May we share our faith so boldly with one another. May we over those simple and casual cups of coffee allow our faith to shine and the love for the Lord to be seen by all.





# MESSAGE FROM PASTOR SETH

Church as Community

What does it look like to have real community? And how is it formed? Is it just something that happens when we meet together regularly with other Christians? Or is there something more to it than just meeting and gathering?

Think back to a time when you experienced deep and meaningful community. What were things that brought you together? Maybe it was a task, an ordeal or a cause that brought you together. Maybe it was an emergency, an unplanned event or a great vision of what could be.

We are to go out on a mission to reach people. We are to teach them to obey everything that Jesus has commanded. And as we are on that mission to reach and disciple people, we would naturally find other people that are on that same mission.

We would stick out because we would be some of the weirdest people on earth. We would stick out because we would be living lives that are radically different than most other Christians.

We do need each other. We would actually need brothers and sisters to come alongside us. We would need brothers and sisters in Christ to help us. We would need a community of people in order to accomplish the mission. We would need to work together and encourage each other to stay on mission. And we would even suffer together as a community.


Here are three ideas to grow deeper in our Christian faith together:

- 1. Hear & Obey Everyone shares what they have heard from God in the in the chapters of Scripture we agreed to read together over the past week and how we have tried to obey. A good way to read and react to Scripture is S.O.A.P.
  - S = Scripture (read the text). O= Observations (What jumps out at you?). A=Application (how does the text apply to you?). P= Pray (Pray over what the Word is teaching).
- 2. Repent & Believe We each repent of our sin, sharing how we have sinned against God this past week. Don't forget to spend time speaking out loud, to you and to one another, the good news of Jesus' work for us; this enables us to believe.
- 3. Pray for Unbelievers Talk about how you've been praying for your unbelieving friends and mention them by name. Explain your plan to weave them into our community.



**FREE MEAL:** Holy Cross is planning to serve a light supper for anyone who attends the Wednesday evening classes: kids in Weekday School and Confirmation Classes, young adults in the

high school / college class, adults in the Life Light classes, and all teachers. The first meal will be served on Wednesday, August 27, from 5:30 - 6:00pm, in the Family Life Center. Even if parents are running late, the kids can take their plates to the classroom at 6:00pm. Adults and children will know ahead of time what is being served!

Kingdom Quest is a fabulous program for Kindergarten through 4th Grade. The GOAL of Kingdom Quest is to provide active discipleship for Kids. One thing is almost certain - Children WILL NOT be bored. Children will begin their Wednesday evening in their very special small group. There are three separate small groups for our Kindergarten through 4th Grade students. Then after small group time, students will transition to a Large Group setting that creatively presents the Bible event. They will get to meet our puppet, Gerdy/Gordy as well as many other amazing people from the Bible!!! After large group time is complete, they will again return to their small groups to be challenged to take their faith into every day situations. The content is very JESUS-centered and each lesson uses active learning methods utilizing their multiple senses. Our awesome small group leaders will focus on connecting kids relationally and helping them apply God's truth in their lives.

5th-7th Grade Confirmation classes will be taught by DCE Kristy Witek. We will be using the fabulous curriculum called Faith Inkubators, which we have used for the past 7 years. Faith Inkubators' goal is Head to the Heart (H2H) - to reach kids and their families for Christ during the exciting, promising, challenging and sometimes rough and rocky teen years. Faith Inkubators' founder Rev. Richard Melheim, spent more than a decade in parish ministry wondering why Bible camp and youth group worked and confirmation didn't. He struggled with the traditional Christian education models that graduated kids on confirmation day, threefourths of them never to return. He wanted to do something about it. The suicides of two young men in his youth group provided him with a slap in the face and helped him create a pastoral care model that blurred the lines between youth group and youth education. Rich spent three years testing this "car load of kids" confirmation system and created something really special – Faith Inkubators! We hope you will join us.

Pastor Schroeder will be leading our 8th Grade Confirmation class and he uses his own curriculum. Mr. Michael Rose leads our Young Adult Class - 9th Grade through 21 years. Adult LifeLight Classes will resume the following week on Wednesday, September 3!


# Bibles Will Be Presented to 2nd Graders Sunday, September 7


## Our biggest outreach event of the year is upon us!


