#### Required Practical Applications

- Read the new *Leaders Manual* in its entirety.
- Personally present the gospel on 3 separate occasions to at least 1 boy.
- Participate in conducting group meetings and activities for at least 3 months.
- Read *Maximized Manhood* by Edwin Louis Cole.
- Plan and conduct an outpost activity with the help of the junior leaders with a focus on applicable safety measures.
- Read *Preventing Child & Substance Abuse*. Review the discussion questions included with a group of boys and/or parents.
- Participate in teaching and/or facilitating the instruction of a leadership merit and its correlating service/ministry project. This requirement does not apply to Ranger Kids leaders. A service/ministry project using the patrol method as it applies in Ranger Kids alone is expected.
- Get a new adult involved in Royal Rangers leadership or service following pastoral guidance.
