

2012 AYM YOUTH CAMP INFO

Early Bird Registration: No phone registration or partial registration will be accepted. Walk-ons may be accepted based on our capacity. Students or Groups registering by the early registration deadline must pay the correct deposit amount to be eligible for the early registration pricing. A Pre-registration Fee of \$50 (non-transferable and non-refundable) must accompany the application. Please see DEADLINE DATES & REGISTRATION COSTS.

Cost: Make checks payable to: Arizona District Council. Camp fees include lodging, meals, and services. We encourage churches to register early to assure them a place at camp.

REGULAR COST: \$200. First come, first served basis will be used for placement in camps as well. It is possible camps could be closed at the door. If not pre-registered, call before coming to the campground, 602.343.4011.

"EARLY BIRD" COST: \$185 total cost to those having full payment in the District Office two weeks prior to the camp you are attending.

DORM LEADER CHILD COST: \$135 for first child.

FAMILY DISCOUNT: \$25 discount off 2nd or more campers at the same camp. Must be immediate family (brother or sister).

Dorm Leader Fee of \$110 must accompany the application.

Refunds: Due to Programming costs, refunds for students who are unable to attend a full week of camp must be requested a minimum of seven days prior to the first day of camp. Refunds must be requested via Email patricia@azag.org. Refunds will be issued at the end of the camping season minus the non-refundable deposit of \$50. We cannot refund monies for partial attendance to a week of camp. No refunds will be given for expelled students.

PLEASE NOTE: PRE-REGISTRATION DEPOSITS ARE NOT REFUNDABLE AND NOT TRANSFERABLE.

Camp Lice Check: All campers are required to have a head check for lice BEFORE registration on the first day of camp. Please do a lice check at your church before leaving for camp. Please See the Lice Check Form and bring it to camp filled out.

Housing: All Students will be housed before arriving on the campgrounds on a first come first serve basis. Add ons cannot be guaranteed to be housed with their group. We will do our best to accommodate housing, but no guarantees.

Arrival/Departure Times: **Registration starts @ 11am** on the first day of camp. Campers are not to be brought and left at camp until they are properly registered. The first meal will be at noon on the first day of camp. **Camp ends @ 10:30am** on the last day of camp. No supervision will be provided after 10:30am on the last day of camp. All campers should depart no later than 10:30am. We will be having a closing rally after breakfast.

Non-Camper Policy: AYM summer camps are CLOSED camps. All camp activities including evening services are open only to registered campers and staff. Any child, student or adult violating this policy will be asked to leave the grounds.

Lost and Found: Any lost or found item left on grounds after the conclusion of camp will be held for one month. If not claimed during that time period, they will be given away. Items will be shipped back to their owners at owners expense.

Camp Property Damage: Charges for items broken/damaged during camp will be billed to all parties/individuals involved.

Insurance: All registered campers and staff members are insured by Brotherhood Mutual Insurance Company. Our Insurance is a secondary policy and your family insurance is primary.

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What to Bring: Sleeping Bags or Bed Sheets, Blanket, pillow, towel, recreational clothes, toiletries, modest swimwear, Bible, spending money for snacks and camp store, gym shoes. Campers are responsible for personal belongings. AYM is not responsible for lost/stolen items.

Expectations: Regulations are given as guidelines for every camper to follow. This code of conduct has been established for your student's protection and the benefit of every person present. The lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect for property, or an unwholesome attitude on the part of any camper will result in expulsion from camp. The expense of transporting the expelled camper will be the parent/guardian expense.

Camp Guidelines:

1. We should strive at all times to conduct ourselves as Christian ladies and gentlemen with proper consideration shown for others.
2. Attendance at all scheduled activities is mandatory.
3. Room and grounds must be kept clean. Take care of property. Campers are responsible to pay for damage to dorms and camp property. Should a offender not be found, the dorm room members will be charged equally.
4. Campers must be in bed and quiet at "lights out."
5. Campers are not to enter another dorm without the counselor's permission.
6. Due to security issues, we have a closed camp.
7. No camper shall be allowed to leave the grounds or go out of bounds without proper permission from a camp executive.
8. Cell phones use is permitted at designated times.

Early Bird Savings: Full Payment two weeks before your week of camp.
