Some Pattern's of Daniel's prayer

1. He recognized the need to pray and was answered – wanted to be part of God's plan – 10:12-13
2. He made time to pray
3. He started with a right view of God – 9:4-9
4. He confessed his sin
5. He relied on God's promises
6. He prayed according to God's will Prayers led by Scripture as all great prayers are Praying according to God's will
