CONNECTING: Connecting to one another with a warm up question or through worship.

What does trusting God and leaning not on your own understanding mean? What does this look like practically?

How are you doing with acknowledging Him day to day? What are the biggest barriers that are keeping you from making a total commitment and saying "yes" to God?

What do you believe is the best way to overcome the world?

What is the best way to renew and transform your mind?

What's the biggest hindrance to you spending time in the Word on a regular basis?

What step will you commit to taking in order to get to know God's book and to intentionally spend time talking to God?

What's the closest friendship you have ever had and what made that friendship so special?

What characteristics would you use to define authentic biblical community?

Why is seeking counsel so important?

How has someone helped you make it through a difficult time? In what ways did they help you?

What are the biggest barriers keeping you from experiencing deeper relationships?

What are some strategic questions that you have come to know and love in your life?

How can we specifically pray for you today?

PRAY IT: Now that you have connected, explored and applied it—it is now time to tap into the power of prayer individually throughout the week as well as corporately praying for one another. Perhaps by sharing the real life challenges and blessings with one another this will help people see what God can do in their lives and will lead them into a plan of action.

- 1. Does God have a clear teaching about this?
- 2. What do my "Coaches" and spiritual advisors/mentors say about it?
 - a. Authority Figures:
 - i. If related to career—What does my authority figure say about it?
 - ii. In our family with our kids—I always like to ask what do you think Grandma would say?
- 3. How will this affect the following:
 - a. Me Spiritually?
 - b. My Family?

Will it draw me/us closer to God or further?

- 4. Is this going to bring more peace and joy or less peace and joy?
 - a. Do I hear God in this?
- 5. What risks come along with this? Am I willing to go for it even if it's hard?
- 6. Are the doors opening/closing?
- 7. Is now the best time for this?
