

Hello HSM Student/Parents,

Thank you so much for signing up for our 2018 HSM Summit High School Winter camp, we're so glad that you will be joining us! Below are some important details we want to make sure you know about. If you have any further questions or concerns, please contact Pastor Josh.

Paying for Camp:

The total cost for camp is \$190 (\$170 if you signed up early). If you have not yet, please make sure to send/bring in a \$50 deposit to hold your spot. Your spot is not reserved until we receive your deposit. All camp payments must be turned in by **Thursday January 11th by 5pm** at the church office or online. We will be sending out e-mail reminders on how much you have left to pay for camp.

Student Drop off:

We will be meeting at the church on Friday, January 12th at 5pm for check-in and will leave the parking lot promptly at 5:45pm to head up the mountain. We will be providing dinner at the church for students going up to winter camp (Little Caesars Pizza) during check-in. If you have any dietary restrictions, please let me know on your "Medical History Form" so we can accommodate you.

Student Pick Up:

We will arrive back to the church on Monday, January 15th no later than 12:30pm. Parents, please show up to pick up your students by 12:15pm. If our return time changes at all we will make sure a leader or your student contacts you on our way back.

Transportation:

We will be taking 15 passenger vans driven by leaders and Pastor Josh. All drivers will be vetted through Northlake's driving policy.

Camp Location:

We will be at the Firs Chalet on Mt. Baker. The Chalet is located a quarter mile from the Heather Meadows Base Area of the Mt. Baker ski resort. There is cell reception at the Chalet so please feel free to call or text me at any time over the weekend if there is anything we need to know.

What to bring:

- Warm clothing for all 4 days
- Toiletries (Soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- A Towel
- Sleeping bag/bedding
- Pillow
- Bible

Optional Items:

What not to bring:

- Fireworks, explosives, or lighters
- Weapons on any kind (guns, knives, etc.)

Electronic Policy:

these items are allowed, students will be <u>highly encouraged</u> to not let their electronics be a distraction.
We will recommend turning devices on airplane mode during camp and only used for their
picture/video features and emergencies.
