Thank you so much for signing up for our 2019 High School Winter Camp. We're so glad that you will be joining us! Below are some important details we want to make sure you know about. If you have any further questions or concerns, please contact Pastor Josh.

Paying for Camp:

You should receive a final amount due for your student's winter camp cost via the e-mail you signed up with. This e-mail will go out by Friday, January 11th. All camp payments must be turned in by **Wednesday, January 16**th by 5pm either at the church office or online.

Medical History Form:

All students attending camp need to turn in a "Medical History Form" (even if they've attend our camps in the past). This form is where you can note your student's dietary restrictions and other needs. The form is included with this letter and more can be found online at northlakeonline.org. Please turn these in ASAP for our records and to make sure we can accommodate any dietary needs.

Camp Location:

We will be at the Firs Chalet on Mt. Baker. The Chalet is located a quarter mile from the Heather Meadows Base Area of the Mt. Baker ski resort. There is cell reception at the Chalet so please feel free to call or text me at any time over the weekend if there is anything we need to know.

In Case of Emergences:

In case of family emergencies, needing to contact your student, or anything else, you can call Pastor Josh's cell phone - **206-427-2843**.

What to bring:

- Warm clothing for all 4 days
- Toiletries (Soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- A towel
- Sleeping bag/Bedding
- Pillow
- Bible, notepad, and a pen
- Snow clothes (winter outerwear)
- Footwear good for snow
- Any medication (presented to Josh upon checking in)

Optional Items:

- Snacks and Candy
- Card games/board games
- Cameras and go-pro's
- Costumes of any kind (it's always fun to dress up and you never know what you can use it for!)
- Ski Equipment (If you would like to go skiing or snowboarding, contact Pastor Josh ASAP **skiing will** only be available if enough students are interested)

What not to bring:

- Drugs, alcohol, or tobacco (all are grounds for immediate dismissal from camp)
- Fireworks, explosives, or lighters
- Weapons of any kind (guns, knives, etc.)

Electronic Policy:

Students are welcome to bring electronics to camp including cell phones and tablets. While these items
are allowed, students will be highly encouraged to not let their electronics be a distraction. We will
recommend turning devices to airplane mode during camp and only using them for their picture/video
features and emergencies.
